District Bearing is a former factory and manufacturing district in Gothenburg, Sweden. Its original purpose was the production of ball bearings, which were then distributed across the world.

The redevelopment of District Bearing seeks to create a unique development in the heart of Gothenburg, a district that adds, complements and strengthens the current urban development in the wider area of Gamlestaden.

The proposals, developed in conjunction with Studio Egret West, provide approximately 1000 homes, alongside office and retail uses, with a focus on introducing exciting new typologies to the city blended with the historic factory setting. Notable historic buildings will be retained and refurbished alongside the intervention of distinctive contemporary mixed-use buildings that add variety and interest against the riverside setting.
